### Call to Order:

#### **New Bills:**

Bill for Post Office box \$94. Don't have bills from Dust Busters or Mike for the dust abatement yet. Motion to pay bills was made and passed. Local Government investment pool will be managing our money and will have website to do transfers via web. Nadyne got a letter from the census bureau asking about doing the census paperwork. The questions are about employees and we don't have any.

## **Old Business:**

Road Wise spread the dust retardant this year. They did a much better job than last year. They ended up using 383 tons instead of the 375 that was estimated. It will come to \$59,700. New Road District meeting signs are up, we only needed three signs replaced.

#### **New Business:**

A member asked about "Road Conditions in LaPine" page on Facebook: someone wrote that speed limit signs are illegal because the county and/or ODOT do not maintain or repair roads. Gary said that our residential roads are considered access roads and that the signs are not illegal, but we cannot enforce the limit. We can report speeders and those who tear up the road to County Sheriff and they will come out and may give a reckless driving ticket.
